Pretty in Peacock



1. Use a sponge to add some subtle color (Shimmer Gold & Ocean Shimmer) to the eyelid. Apply a stencil (00H! S04 in Royal Purple) on top for extra interest.



Arty Cake. Paint a circle shape ending in a narrow stroke towards the inner corner of the eye for the peacock's head and neck.

Add a C-shaped stroke hugging the eye, some feather shaped strokes in the outer corner and a swirly S-shaped stroke underneath the eye.





4. Fit in a V-shape wherever you would like to paint
a peacock feather.

Fill in the V-shape with a peddle stroke

Fill in the V-shape with a peddle stroke (darkest color on the INside)



5. Flip your brush (darkest color on the OUTside) and paint a peddle-like stroke hugging the previous one. Whilst painting on the very tip of your flat brush add subtle lines surrounding the peddle shape and downwards the center of the feather to finish it off.



With a round brush no. 2 or no.
 add some outlining and details to the peacock's head. Add some extra interest by painting some swirls, curls and teardrops over and in between the Peacock feather strokes. (used color here is Snow Petrol)
