

Rainbow Tiger

1 - Sponge white onto the eyelids, over the eyebrow up onto the forehead in a triangular shape. With the same sponge add white under the nose to create the muzzle. Sponge yellow in the center. Cover the nose and blending it out onto the beginning of the cheeks and forehead.



2 - Next sponge the blue on the face beside the yellow. Flip your sponge and blend the edge. Leaving space for the next color



3 - Sponge the pink next, right beside the blue and blend.



4 - Load your favorite round with Black. From the corner of the eye use a thin to thick motion and trace along the triangular shape. Using a wing type swing motion to finish the outer outline.



5 - Use the same thick to thin technique to add the lines onto the cheeks. I echo the curves of the muzzle starting under the eye and working my way up the cheekbones.
