# Hulk Balloon Candy Cup

## Use of Balloon Candy Cups:

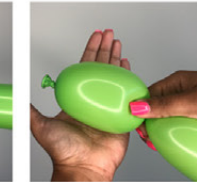
- Centerpieces filled with candies or colored rocks. They take less space in the table than a regular centerpiece.
- Party Favors. 3 in 1 (decoration during party time, balloon figures and goody bags)
- Add one special cup for the birthday child for "FREE". Just add the price of the cup into your face paint/balloon packet. I always try to have something special for the birthday child. It shows that you are going the extra mile for their family and a lot of people appreciate that.
- As marketing for doctor offices, children places. You can make one and deliver it with your business cards to these places.
- As a special gift to someone. There are many holidays during the year and some people look for something unique.



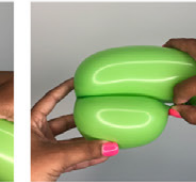
Inflate the 5-inch round balloon and before tying it put it through the dome lid and let go of the air little by little until you are able to close the cup, then tie.



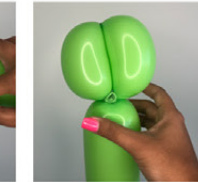
To make the head/torso, inflate the 350 lime green balloon and leave a long tail.



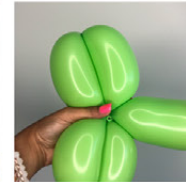
Make a 4-finger segment (this will be the head)



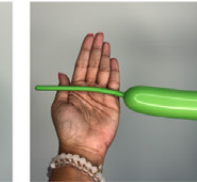
Make a second segment of same size and tie together with the nozzle.



You will do the same for the torso but with a 5-finger segment.



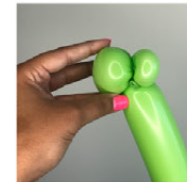
At the end get rid of the rest of the balloon and tie.



To make the arms, inflate the 260 lime green balloon and leave a handtail.



Make a small loop and feed the nozzle through.



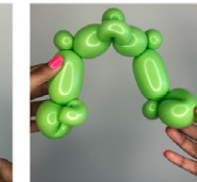
Then make a small bubble and pinch twist that bubble. This will be the hand.



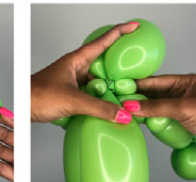
Leave a 4-finger segment and do a small pinch twist (shoulder)



Make a small 2-finger segment and then do 2 pinch twists (neck)



Now to the other side you will do the same: small segment, pinch twist, bigger segment, small loop and pinch twist



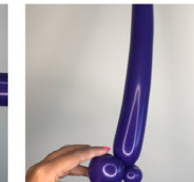
Twist the 2 pinch twists of the neck in the



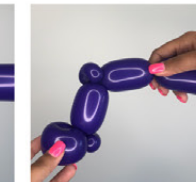
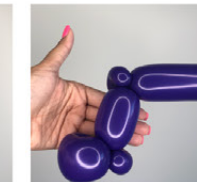
middle of the head/torso balloon we did earlier.



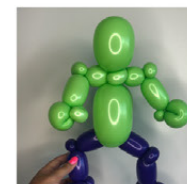
To make the legs, inflate the 260 purple balloon and leave a hand-tail.



Make a medium sized loop and feed the nozzle through. Then make a small bubble and pinch twist that bubble. This will be the feet Leave a 4-finger segment and do a small pinch twist (knee)



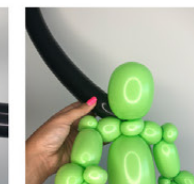
Leave another 4-finger segment and feed through the torso balloon.



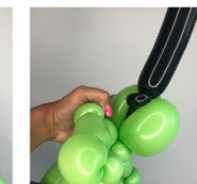
Now to the other side you will do the same: segment, pinch twist, segment, loop, pinch twist



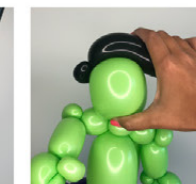
To make the hair, inflate the 260 black balloon and leave a hand-tail.



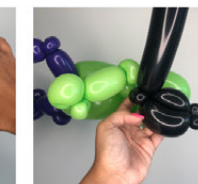
Twist the nozzle of the black balloon around the neck.



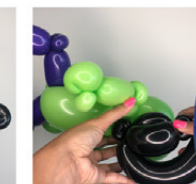
Squish the air on the side of the balloon and then make a pinch twist



Measure the head and twist a segment and do another pinch twist on that side.



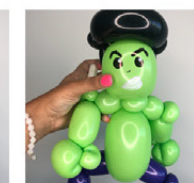
Twist another segment to go back to the first pinch twist we did.



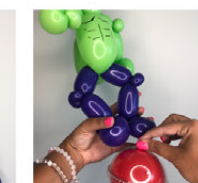
Go back to the other pinch twist but with a longer segment. This will be the front of the hair.



Then squish the balloon and twist around the neck on the other side.



Draw the face and the abs on the torso



Attach both legs to the nozzle of the round balloon that is on the cup.
